## Certificate and Students Class Record

A certificate and a student’s class record are issued upon graduating as long as s/he has at least attended 90 % of his/her classes. Student’s class record includes class behaviour, scores and levels that shows his/her English level improvement and overall performance evaluated by the teachers.

## Class Regulation

1. Schedules assigned is ranking dependent.
2. Special class is provided depending on the student’s level and purpose of training. Once a student applies, s/he will be strictly monitored for 2 weeks. Thus, attendance is a must.
3. Going out is prohibited from Mondays to Fridays.
4. Students may go on a trip on weekends and holidays.
5. English zones are designated where speaking English is strictly enforced.
6. Group classes and Special classes are subject to change.
7. 1 class consists of 45 minutes class time and a 10 minute break.

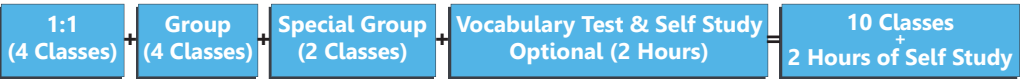

# PS-Working Holiday

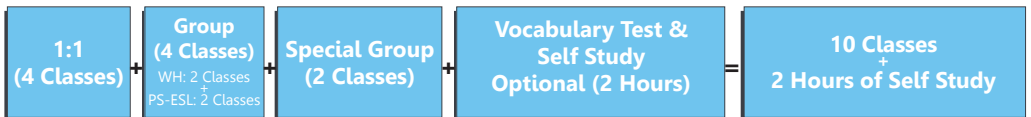

## Class Regulation

1. All group classes are divided according to levels. A student should choose group classes according to his/her level.
2. Four classes is the standard number of classes in a day. Total attendance is checked every 2 weeks.
3. New students may add or change their subjects after 2 weeks.
4. Students who apply for 5 classes must attend all 5 classes during 2 weeks.
5. English zones are designated where speaking English is strictly enforced.
6. Changing of schedule (add classes, change classes and change class schedule) is done every 2 weeks.
7. 1 hour class is 45 minutes study and 10 minutes.

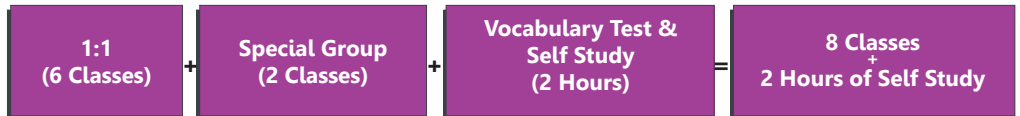

## 2:2:1:1 SYSTEM

Most Language Academies around the world have almost the same number of classes. Usually, they have 1 class for the 1:1 core subjects (1 class each for Listening, Reading, Writing and Speaking). JIC also started out like that but being the pioneer academy of IELTS, we have been able to change, pilot, and improve our curriculum to what we have now. The advantage of the 2:2:1:1 is that it concentrates on writing and speaking as these are usually the main weak points of students. By focusing on these core subjects, students of JIC have been getting there score faster and improve quicker.

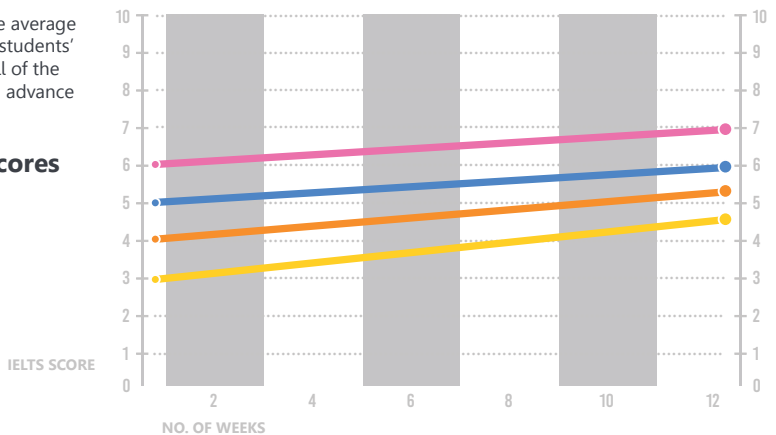


FIGURE 2: Duration of Improvements

- If a student fails to achieve his/her goal score within the guarantee period, JIC will provide for his/her tuition fee only (excluding accommodation, pocket money, visa fee, electric/water, etc.)
- The student has regular consultation with the head teacher twice a week
- One speaking prescription will be given in a term
- One weekly mock test and review will also be given
- Unlimited writing evaluation

## Guarantee Program Regulation

1. The student must have 100% attendance (if sick, student must submit a medical certificate)
2. The student must follow the regulations of the IELTS Program. The student must not exceed 15 points of cumulative penalty points and must not receive any warning from the manager.
3. The student must not change his/her program module during the enrolment period.
4. If the student takes the official test before his/her designated period ends and the student's OBS decreases, then s/he will lose the benefits of the guarantee program. (latest test score)

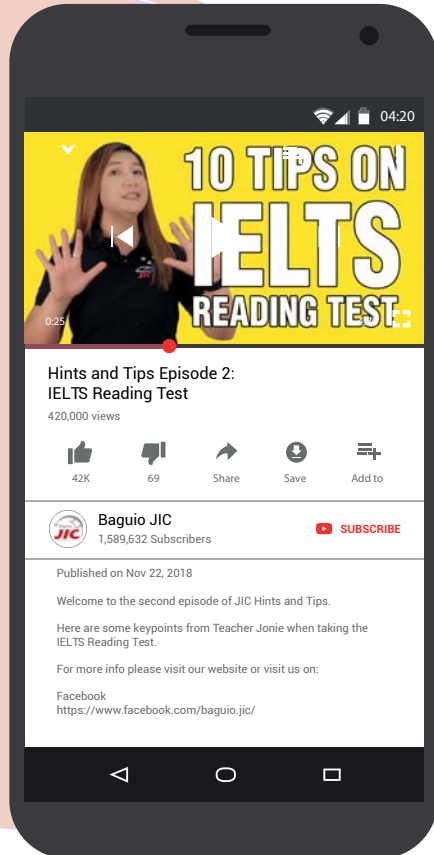

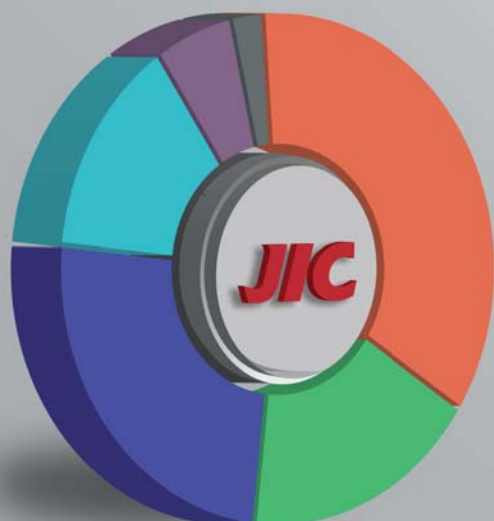

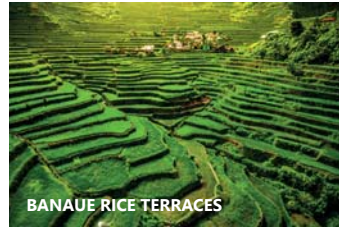
